

## **BRUIN NOVICE LEGISLATION A.**

### **A Bill to Automatically Register the Voting Age Population**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1. **SECTION 1.** Voting eligible citizens shall be automatically
2.     registered to vote in elections held at any level.
3. **SECTION 2.** “Voting eligible citizen” shall be defined as any
4.     American born or naturalized citizen aged eighteen or older.
5. **SECTION 3.** Individual state Election Commissions shall be
6.     responsible for maintaining rolls of new voters.
7.     The U.S. Department of Justice shall be responsible for
8.     ensuring compliance among the states.
9. **SECTION 4.** This bill shall take effect January 1, 2021.
10. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with the provisions of this bill
11.     shall be declared null and void.

## **BRUIN NOVICE LEGISLATION B.**

### **A Bill to Promote Democracy in Afghanistan**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1. **SECTION 1.** \$5 billion in aid shall be given annually to the Islamic
2. State of Afghanistan to promote the creation of a democracy, and
3. all US troops will be immediately withdrawn from Afghanistan.
4. **SECTION 2.** “Democracy” shall be defined as a government without
5. corruption or human rights abuses, where its officials are elected
6. into office through democratic vote.
7. **SECTION 3.** The State Department shall be responsible for
8. enforcing the distribution of aid and the Defense Department
9. shall be responsible for enforcing the withdrawal of all US troops.
10. **SECTION 4.** This bill shall take effect January 1, 2021.
11. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with the provisions of this bill
12. shall be declared null and void.

# **BRUIN NOVICE LEGISLATION C.**

## **A Resolution to Ensure the Right to Be Forgotten**

1. **WHEREAS**, Internet users' information is collected and often
2.     disseminated to third parties; and
3. **WHEREAS**, search engines, social media platforms, and others
5.     gather information for advertisers; and
6. **WHEREAS**, the information gathered on users has become refined
7.     to the point of knowing far past the identity of the user; and
8. **WHEREAS**, Due to recent data breaches, most Americans would
9.     like to be able to request that their information is deleted; and
11. **WHEREAS**, other developed democracies such as the European
12.    Union have acknowledged the need for a right for privacy; now,
13.    therefore, be it
14. **RESOLVED**, By the Congress here assembled that search engines,
15.    social media platforms, and others remove information about
16.    an individual upon the request of the individual, within thirty
17.    days of such request.

# **BRUIN NOVICE LEGISLATION D.**

## **A Bill to Ban Animal Testing for Commercial and Scientific Use**

BE IT ENACTED BY THIS CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1. **SECTION 1.** All animal testing will cease immediately and test
2. animals will be relocated to nature institutes.
3. **SECTION 2.** Animal Testing may be defined as any scientific
4. experiment or test in which a live animal is forced to undergo
5. something that can cause them pain, suffering, distress, or lasting
6. harm.
7. **SECTION 3.** The U.S. Public Health Service will oversee the
8. implementation of this bill. The FDA and CDC operate underneath
9. the Public Health Service.
10. **SECTION 4.** This bill shall be carried out by the end of 2021.
11. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
12. declared null and void.

## **BRUIN NOVICE LEGISLATION E.**

### **A Bill to Forgive All Student Loan Debt after Five Years**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1. SECTION 1.** All current and future student loan debt held by
- 2.** individuals after five years of qualifying payments shall be
- 3.** forgiven.
- 4. SECTION 2.** Student loan debt refers to debt from loans for higher
- 5.** education, qualifying payments refer to timely payments made
- 6.** toward paying off student loans, forgiven means that the remaining
- 7.** money owed will be the burden of the lender to cover.
- 8. SECTION 3.** The United States Department of Education and the
- 9.** United States Treasury will oversee the enforcement of the bill to
- 10.** ensure no violations occur by lenders and that all qualifying
- 11.** payments are processed.
- 12. SECTION 4.** This bill shall be go into effect immediately.
- 13. SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby
- 14.** declared null and void.

# **BRUIN NOVICE LEGISLATION F.**

## **A Bill to Ban Solitary Confinement**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1. **SECTION 1.** Solitary confinement shall be prohibited at all Federal
2. Prisons across the United States.
3. **SECTION 2.** Solitary confinement is defined as a prisoner who is
4. kept away from other prisoners as a form of punishment.
5. **SECTION 3.** The Federal Bureau of Prisons (BOP) shall oversee the
6. enforcement of this bill. The BOP shall receive \$1 billion to
7. overhaul the system.
8. **SECTION 4.** This bill will be enacted immediately upon passage.
9. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby  
declared null and void.
