Speechwire | Online Ballot Instructions

First:

- o Judges need a valid e-mail and access to that e-mail during the tournament for online ballots.
- Once linked, Judges should find an e-mail from Speechwire sent to them with their password to access the ballots online.
- You will get <u>an email blast with your judge assignments</u>. You can also sign up for *text alerts* if you prefer at <u>speechwire.com/subscribe</u>, and there will be a paper list of assignments posted in the judge's room in case you can't get either for some reason.

Next:

1. **LOGIN IN**: Judges can access their ballots by going to the SpeechWire e-balloting website, which is at: <u>ballots.speechwire.com</u>. Once on the website, they need to type in their email address and the password on their SpeechWire account. (For coaches, this is the same as their SpeechWire coach account.)
