A Bill Banning Dancing to the National Anthem

1	Be it enacted by the Student Congress here assembled that:		
2	Article 1.	It is illegal to dance while singing or listening to any rendition of the	
3		national anthem.	
4	Article 2.	The term "national anthem" means "The Star-Spangled Banner" by	
5		Francis Scott Key and John Stafford Smith.	
6	Article 3.	This law will take effect on January 1, 2022.	
7	Article 4.	The Department of State shall have jurisdiction over this legislation.	
8		A. Whoever plays, sings or renders "The Star Spangled Banner" in	
9		any public place, theatre, motion picture hall, restaurant or café, or	
10		at any public entertainment, other than as a whole and separate	
11		composition or number, without embellishment or addition in the	
12		way of national or other melodies, or whoever plays, sings or	
13		renders "The Star Spangled Banner," or any part thereof, as dance	
14		music, as an exit march or as a part of a medley of any kind, shall	
15		be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.	
16	Article 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Annex Canada

1	Be it enacted by the Student Congress here assembled that:		
2	Article 1.	The Provinces of British Columbia, Manitoba, Nova Scotia, New	
3		Brunswick, Newfoundland and Labrador, Ontario, Prince Edward Island,	
4		Quebec, and Saskatchewan, as well as the Northwest Territories, Nunavut,	
5		and Yukon, shall be annexed by the United States,	
8	Article 2.	The President of the United States is authorized to pay the governments of	
9		these aforementioned Canadian provinces and territories \$5 trillion as	
10		compensation for this annexation, to be divided up equally based on the	
11		2020 population of each province and territory. Payment shall be made in	
12		equal annual increments between January 1, 2022 and December 31, 2032.	
12	Article 3.	This law will take effect on January 1, 2022.	
13	Article 4.	The Department of Treasury and the Department of State will oversee the	
14		provisions of this bill.	
15	Article 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
