1 Be it enacted by this Palm Beach Catholic Forensic League Student Congress here
2 assembled that:

3 Article I: All United States military personnel and equipment will begin a
4 a withdrawal from South Korea.

5 Article II: Equipment includes defense systems, vehicles, and all weaponry.

6 Article III: The implementation will begin immediately upon passage.

7 Article IV: The Department of Defense will oversee the implementation of
8 this bill and go along with the safest withdrawal they decide.

**A Bill to Ensure Federal Officeholder Candidate Quality
By Requiring a Series of Qualification Tests**

1 Be it enacted by this Palm Beach Catholic Forensic League Student Congress here
2 assembled that:

3 Article I: Due to recent concerns regarding the ability of federal public officeholders
4 to effectively govern, a series of tests shall be implemented to determine
5 the mental and physical strength levels of all candidates seeking federal
6 office regardless of position.

7 Article II: This series of tests shall include:

8 A) A mental health test created and administered by the U.S. Office of
9 Personal Management.

10 B) A physical health test created and administered by the U.S. Office
11 of Personal Management.

12 C) An American historical and Constitutional knowledge test created
13 and administered by the U.S. Office of Personal Management.

14 Article III: This bill shall be implemented at the start of the 2024 general election
15 cycle at whichever date the earliest election occurs

13 Article IV: The United States Department of Labor and the Federal Election
14 Commission shall oversee the implementation and enforcement of this
15 bill.

16 Article V: All other laws in conflict with this new policy shall be null and void.

The Parental Citizenship Act

1 Be it enacted by this Palm Beach Catholic Forensic League Student Congress here
2 assembled that:

3 Article I: Any individual who is a parent of a child born in the United States shall be
4 eligible for citizenship upon the fulfillment of the requirements set forth in
5 this Act.

5 Article II: Requirements to obtain citizenship will shall be defined as follows:

6 (A) The individual must have been physically present in the United
7 States for a continuous period of not less than nine months prior to
8 the date of application for citizenship.

9 (B) The individual must have been a person of good moral character
10 during the nine-month period.

11 (C) The individual must demonstrate a basic understanding of the
12 English language and a knowledge of United States history and
13 government.

14 (D) The individual must be a parent of a child who is a citizen of the
15 United States by virtue of being born in the United States

16 Article III: An individual seeking citizenship under this Act shall submit an
17 application on a form prescribed by the Secretary of Homeland Security,
18 along with any required fees and documentation.

19 Article IV: The Secretary of Homeland Security shall approve the application of any
20 individual who meets the requirements set forth in this Act.

21 Article V: Upon approval of an application for citizenship under this Act, the
22 individual shall be required to take the oath of allegiance to the United
23 States.

24 Article VI: All other laws in conflict with this new policy shall be null and void.

A Bill to Legalize the Sale of Human Organs

1 Be it enacted by this Palm Beach Catholic Forensic League Student Congress here
2 assembled that:

3 Article I: As means of producing greater efficiency in access to life-saving
4 treatment, federally-recognized hospitals will gain access to buy, sell,
5 and transfer human organs intended to be utilized in procedures that are
6 medically necessary.

7 Article II: Procedures deemed “medically necessary” shall be defined as those which
8 hospitals deems necessary to maintain or restore a patient’s health or
9 treat a medical problem. A licensing system for hospitals allowed to
10 distribute organs will be implemented for the purpose of holding approved
11 facilities accountable and making sure they are properly conducting
12 storage procedures.

13 Article III: This bill will be enacted January 1, 2024.

14 Article IV: The department of Health and Human Services shall oversee the
15 implementation of this bill.

16 Article V: All other laws in conflict with this new policy shall be null and void.
