A Bill to Fund the Great Green Wall to Slow Down Climate Change, Desertification, and Poverty in Africa

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1	SECTION 1.	The United States shall provide funding to African Nations in order for
2		them to be able to continue and have better construction on the Great
3		Green Wall.
4	SECTION 2.	The Great Green Wall is a project led by the African Union, initially
5		conceived as a way to combat desertification, climate change, and extreme
6		poverty in the Sahel Region, and hold back expansion of the Sahara by
7		planting a wall of trees stretching across the entire Sahel.
8	SECTION 3.	This legislation shall be enforced by the US agency for International
9		Development to fund the Great Green Wall.
10		A. A \$1 billion dollar annual fund shall be allocated to the US Agency for
11		International Development to fund the Great Green Wall.
12	SECTION 4.	This legislation will take effect at the start of FY 2024.
13	SECTION 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Lift Sanctions on Cuba

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1	SECTION 1. The United States remove all sanctions and embargoes
2	currently placed on the Republic of Cuba.
3	SECTION 2. Sanctions and embargoes will include any special restrictions
4	on travel or trade between the United States and Cuba.
5	SECTION 3. The Department of State, Department of Commerce, and the
6	Department of the Treasury shall be tasked with the implementation of this
7	legislation.
8	SECTION 4. This legislation will go into effect immediately upon
	passage.

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
