- Writing up post-National Tournament BIS Report
- Working alongside members of the NSDA staff on elimination round paneling
- Assisting with facilitation of coaches' caucus meetings at National Tournament
- Other duties as assigned.

This is a 150-hour internship with an option for an additional 150 hours depending upon the NSDA's and intern's satisfaction with the experience and desire to work additional hours. Responsibilities in this instance would include:

- Assisting with the facilitation of the Multicultural Learning Alliance
