Events

- Debate (No double entry)
- Speech (Maximum 3 events; no more than 2 events per pattern)
  - Pattern A: DX, FX, DI, Duo, Info, Prose, Storytelling
  - Pattern B: HI, OO, POI, POE, Impromptu, SW

There are three divisions:

Varsity Division Qualification (any one requirement must be met)

- Have earned 500 NSDA points
- Qualifier to the NSDA
- Qualifier to the NCFL
- State Tournament Champion
- NIETOC Qualifier
- Earned 1 TOC bid

Novice Division Qualification

- Open invitational for any student in grades 9-10 who are also in their first year of competition

Middle School Qualification

- Open invitational for any student in grades 6-8

### **NSDA National Championship Tournament**

Des Moines, IA

June 16-21, 2024

1) **Eligibility requirements** must be met before the tournament begins:

- A) School annual membership activated
- B) Student membership in the NSDA (earn 25 NFL points)
- C) Student registration (student must create an account/login with NSDA)
- D) Students must complete the Single Entry Letter of Intent if entered in more than one NSDA event

2) **Events** earning slots at nationals

- Original Oratory (1 qualifier)
- US Extemp [DX] (1 qualifier)
- International Extemp [FX] (1 qualifier)
- Humorous Interp (1 qualifier)
- Dramatic Interp (1 qualifier)

- Public Forum (1 qualifier)
- Lincoln Douglas Debate (1 qualifier)
- Policy Debate (1 qualifier)
- Congressional Debate (2 qualifiers... by resume application to Shawn Briscoe)
- World Schools Debate (1 qualifier—3-5 students... by resume application to Shawn Briscoe)
