- Our tournament will consist of 3 preliminary rounds, and a final round.
- There will be 1 judge in each preliminary round, and 3 judges in each final round.
- Judging assignments will be posted on <u>live.speechwire.com</u>; Schematics will be posted on speechwire.com.
- If you would like a program of the Section 2A Tournament, listing titles and authors, please access one found on the Section 2A Speech website.
- Please rank all the way out; no speaker points.
- Discussion Tasks will be posted on the <u>LIVE DOC posted here</u>.
 - o Tasks will come from III: A, C & IV: A, C, E
- Judges are NOT expected to serve as timers during the tournament. If judges would like
 to time speakers, they may, but are asked to refrain from providing time signals. Time
 should NOT affect rank.
- Please check the <u>Workers Schedule</u> to know if there will be a Timer/Room Manager present. Timers will time all rounds for draw categories. All other categories will be timed once during a preliminary round and during the final round, with the exception of Discussion. Judges will also serve as Timers in Discussion rounds.
- If you need to report a perceived rules violation, please report any violations to the Tab Room, room 242. <u>Ask for Jessie Oelke</u>, Tournament Director.
- Payment of \$175 can be collected after completion of your judging duties at the end of the evening.

Workers

- The Coaches' & Workers' Lounge is located in room 247.
- Use this map to help you navigate the building.
- Please check the <u>Workers Schedule</u> to know which room and category you are responsible for. Arrive at your assigned post AT LEAST five minutes before the round begins. Do NOT switch assignments.
- Timers will time all rounds for draw categories (extemp speaking, extemp reading, storytelling). All other categories will be timed once during a preliminary round and during the final round. Make sure you have a stopwatch, as well as a timer packet.
 Please find additional instructions on this document (also found in your timer packet).
- Readers will read for all rounds of Extemp Reading. Please make sure you have both a
 prose and poetry book, as well as a reader packet. A selection of all cuttings/readings
 will be provided so that you can follow along with the speaker.
- Please report any infractions to the Tournament Director, <u>Jessie Oelke</u>, immediately after the round has finished. Do NOT report any infractions to judges or competitors. As a reminder: you are looking for infractions that you deem intentional, not accidental.
