Reminders for Judges

1. First, thank you so much for helping at our Laker Legacy Tournament! We are so excited to have you here with us today!
2. Please find a space in the Foods room.
3. We will be having a Judges meeting at 8:40am in the Foods room.
4. You will find a school map attached to this document. The High School is a big square. It is super easy to walk through. The Middle School has 2 long hallways, one on the bottom and one on the top.
5. The TAB room will be next door in the Staff Lounge.
6. Scripts are ok! Please do not adjust rank based on the use of a script, unless they are blocking facial expression, being used as a prop and so on.
7. Please do not comment on Students clothing unless it is too revealing or inappropriate. - If this is the case, please come to the TAB room and we will let the coach know.
8. Round times start at 9:10 A.M., 10:35 A.M., and 12:00 P.M. There will be no final round.
9. Lunch will be available around 11:00 A.M.
10. Rank out all competitors. The TAB room will adjust rank to the lowest room number in that category. Percentages run 87-100, and no one can have the same percentage.
11. Do not include the rank and percentages on the critiques. Record these on the ballots only.
12. Please provide critiques that can be positive, as well as what students can work on. Some have just finished Conferences, some have Conferences in the next week or so. We are over halfway through the season, so it is all about those little things that they can be working on, as well as major things. So, please take the time to provide **detailed critiques**. Please note their time on the critique, as well.
13. If the student goes over on time, it is ok unless they go WAY over on time. If so, feel free to stop them.
14. Please do not give oral critiques.
15. Paper critiques will be available outside the TAB room before all rounds, where you will also drop off your ballot if you prefer paper critiques.
16. **Discussion tasks** will be on paper. Please hand these out to the students face down at the start of the round. You may enter your critiques online or in paper form. These tasks will be available outside the TAB room.
