



# 2025 CHSAA 5A State Tournament Semi Final Session Bill A

## A Bill to Establish a Universal Basic Income Program to Address Economic Inequality

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The United States shall implement a Universal Basic Income (UBI)  
3 program providing \$1,000 per month to all adult citizens.

4 **SECTION 2.** "Universal Basic Income" is defined as a government program providing  
5 all adult citizens with a standard amount of money on a regular basis,  
6 regardless of employment status or income level.

7 **SECTION 3.** The Department of the Treasury shall oversee the implementation of this  
8 program.

9 A. Funding for the UBI program shall be derived from a combination of a  
10 value-added tax (VAT) of 10% on goods and services, and the  
11 consolidation of existing welfare programs.

12 B. The Internal Revenue Service shall be responsible for distributing  
13 monthly payments and ensuring compliance.

14 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on July 1, 2026. All laws in conflict with this  
15 legislation are hereby declared null and void.



## 2025 CHSAA 5A State Tournament Semi Final Session Bill B

### A Bill to Require Employers to Provide Employees with Paid Parental Leave

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1   **SECTION 1.**   All employers shall provide all employees with paid parental leave,  
2                   regardless of gender
- 3   **SECTION 2.**   The minimum amount of parental leave provided by an employer shall be  
4                   12 weeks for any employee who has been employed for a minimum of one  
5                   year. Parental leave is defined as time taken off by someone who is a  
6                   guardian to a minor. It can be taken up to one month before the end of a  
7                   pregnancy, finalization of adoption, or foster care placement.
- 8   **SECTION 3.**   The Bureau of Labor will oversee regulation of this policy in ensuring that  
9                   employers are providing this benefit to employees. The IRS will oversee the  
10                  regulation of business taxes for the purpose of creating a fund to be  
11                  utilized by smaller businesses. For companies that make less than 2 million  
12                  USD in annual revenue, 0.5% of tax dollars will go into a fund that  
13                  companies can use to compensate their employees on parent leave.
- 14                  A. Subsections may be used to elaborate further details, but only needed  
15                  if you need to have more than one subsection.
- 16                  B. This would be a second subsection.
- 17   **SECTION 4.**   This legislation shall take effect on January 1, 2026. All laws in conflict with  
18                   this legislation are hereby declared null and void.



# 2025 CHSAA 5A State Tournament Semi Final Session Resolution C

## The Second Bill of Rights

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1 **RESOLVED,** By two-thirds of the Congress here assembled, that the following article is  
2 proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the United States, which  
3 shall be valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when  
4 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several states within  
5 seven years from the date of its submission by the Congress:

6 **ARTICLE --**

7 **SECTION 1:** To ensure a better and fairer standard of living for the People  
8 of the United States, Congress shall make no Law and the several States  
9 shall enforce no Law that abridges or infringes on the Rights of the  
10 individual necessary for economic self-determination and just participation  
11 in a Free Market. These Rights shall include the right to a useful and  
12 remunerative job with a reasonable commute, the right to afford adequate  
13 food and clothing and recreation for themselves and those dependent  
14 upon them with only the earnings of an honest workweek, the right of a  
15 farmer to raise and sell their products at a return which will provide a  
16 decent standard of living for them and their family, the right to an  
17 affordable place of living that is safe and adequate and affordable  
18 maintenance for their place of living, the right to affordable healthcare of a  
19 quality which allows for the full opportunity to live a long life in the  
20 enjoyment of good health, the right to be protected from the economics  
21 fears and burdens consequent of old age and sickness or happenstance for  
22 their contributions to a safe community and a prosperous economy, and  
23 the right to an affordable education of a quality which ensures they are  
24 literate and competent and capable of independent living and contributing  
25 to the workforce.

26 **SECTION 2:** The Congress shall have the power to enforce this article  
through the appropriate legislation.

# A Resolution to Amend the Constitution to Abolish the Electoral College to Implement a National Popular Vote in Presidential Elections

1     **RESOLVED,**     By two-thirds of the Congress here assembled, that the following article  
2                       is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the United States,  
3                       which shall be valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Constitution  
4                       when ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several states  
5                       within seven years from the date of its submission by the Congress:

## ARTICLE --

**SECTION 1:** The Electoral College is hereby abolished. The President and Vice President of the United States shall be elected by a direct national popular vote. The candidate receiving the greatest number of votes cast by the people of the United States shall be elected President, and the candidate receiving the second greatest number of votes shall be elected Vice President, unless running jointly, in which case the candidates shall be elected together as President and Vice President.

**SECTION 2:** The Congress shall have power to enforce this article by appropriate legislation.

## A Bill to Lower Prescription Drug Costs

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** The FDA shall enact a markup cap for all prescription drugs.
- 2 **SECTION 2.** The mark-up percentage shall be capped at 10% for all prescription drugs.
- 3 **SECTION 3.** The following definitions apply.
  - 4 A. Prescription drugs - any drug that is given through a prescription
  - 5 B. Markup cap - A limit on how much a business can mark up the price of
  - 6 a product.
- 7 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on January 31, 2028. All laws in conflict with this
- 8 legislation are hereby declared null and void.
