A Bill to Ban Pineapple on Pizza

SECTION 1. This bill proposes a nationwide prohibition on the use of pineapple as a topping on commercially prepared pizza, in an effort to preserve traditional culinary standards and protect the sanctity of classic pizza flavors.

- 1. Ban on Pineapple Pizza: All restaurants, food trucks, and commercial food establishments are prohibited from preparing, selling, or advertising pizza that contains pineapple as a topping.
- 2. Cultural Exceptions: Pineapple pizza may be served on official Hawaiian state holidays or at international cultural exchange events, with a clearly displayed disclaimer.
- 3. Pizza Purity Council: The bill establishes a Pizza Purity Council under the Department of Culinary Standards to oversee enforcement, review topping combinations, and issue warnings for non-compliance.
- SECTION 3. This bill aims to uphold culinary integrity, promote respectful pizza practices, and prevent further polarization of the pizza-loving population.
- This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2026. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
