Thank you for entering the 2025 Vocal Viking. We appreciate the support of this comprehensive tournament. Here is some information to help you prepare for the tournament.

Parking

On Friday, please park in Lots 5 or 7. However, there are several other events going on, parking might be at a premium. Park where you find a spot! You will not need a parking pass. Please look at the map on the last page. On Saturday, you can park in any lot but Lot 6 (the back door to Meyer Hall will be locked). We recommend lots 5 or 7 for Saturday. See the map for more information. Of course, Visitor spots are available to visitors and handicap parking is available for those with proper permits.

Check-in

The tournament headquarters will be in Honsey Hall. Check in and ballot table will be outside Honsey Hall 200, just inside the entrance of Honsey Hall by the corner of Marsh and Division streets. Registration begins at 11 am. Round 1 of Parliamentary Debate begins at 11:30. For those only doing individual events, feel free to register later in the day during the first two rounds of debate. Round 1 of IEs begins with Extemp draw at 2 pm.

Electronic Ballots

The Vocal Viking will use electronic ballots. Please bring a laptop or tablet computer that can connect to the internet. You can connect to the "student" wifi without a password.

Food

Breakfast will be provided on Saturday morning starting at 7:30 am outside Honsey Hall room 239. You can purchase lunch on Saturday in our Dining Center for \$9.65+tax per person. You can pay at the door. There are several vending machines located throughout the campus. The judges' lounge will be well stocked. Mankato has a number of online food delivery services as well.

Weather

According to The Weather Channel website, last accessed on October 29, Mankato will have cooler weather both days. Highs will be in the mid-40s, lows around freezing. There is a chance of rain on Friday. All the builds we are using are connected by tunnels. Your students should only have to be outside to go to and from your vehicle.

Smoking

Bethany only allows smoking in designated areas. All participants will be given maps with the areas properly marked. Smoking is NOT allowed near the entrances to buildings.

Pumpkin Carving Contest

Events: ADS, DUO, PER, and POE will either have a second judge in a prelim round and not break to finals.

Parliamentary Debate will only have an Open division. Parli will break to quarterfinals.

Buildings

The Vocal Viking will primarily use Honsey Hall for the tournament. We will augment with Meyer Hall and the basement of Trinity Chapel. All buildings are connected by tunnels, so students should not have to go outside.

Event Reminders

Impromptu Speaking will have <u>cartoons</u> in round 1, <u>objects</u> in round 2, and <u>quotations</u> in finals. The 7 minutes will start 15 seconds after the student has seen the prompt. There will be a separate prompt for each speaker, so no one needs to leave the room.

Parliamentary Debate will be run using "Upper-Midwest-Style". No coaching or group prep during the 15 minutes of preparation time. We announce the topic in the room. No research during prep time. A dictionary is the only thing to access. No warm room. No "flex" time. Remember, you are allowed to bring a copy of the NPDA rules of debate into the room.
