

LIVE.SPEECHWIRE.COM – HOW TO ACCESS AND COMPLETE YOUR BALLOT

STEP #1

- Go to live.speechwire.com and sign in.
- Click on your ballot.





- Start speech rounds even if a competitor is missing. The missing competitor can still compete if they arrive late and the round has not finished.
