- 1) **Eligibility requirements** must be met *before the tournament begins*:
 - A) School annual membership activated (*one week prior*)
 - B) Student membership in the NSDA (earn 25 NFL points + pay lifetime membership fee)
 - C) Student registration (student must create an account/login with NSDA)
 - D) Students must complete the Single Entry Letter of Intent if entered in more than one NSDA event

 - Original Oratory (1 qualifier)
 - US Extemp [DX] (1 qualifier)
 - International Extemp [FX] (1 qualifier)
