A Bill to Tax for Imperial Infrastructure

A Bill to Establish the Zero Point Recollection and Protection Act Under The Seven and IO Supervision

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1: The Seven (ex: Dwane “The Rock” Johnson) finds that the shattering of the Zero Point has caused a fracture in the timeline, leaving the Island volatile to invasion.

SECTION 2: In coordination with all characters of the Fortnite-verse, the following measures will be taken: a) any player suspected of “sweating” will be forced to wear a dunce cap on their avatar to indicate their ineptitude for joint-collaboration to re-establish the Zero Point ; b) all NPC’s (Ex: Peely, Goku, Travis Scott), will be placed on the in-game map to recollect, stabilize, and protect the Zero Point (all attempted and/or executed harm on these NPC’s will result in an immediate kick from the current match); c) the leader of The Seven Dwane Johnson will oversee that Dr. Sloane and Agent Jonesy stick to the Zero Point protocol and any efforts of retaliation will cause a non-skippable Live Event dedicated to mass shaming said characters, mandatory for the entirety of the player base to spectate and participate in such ridicule (Ex: Hitting the Take the L Emote, Throwing a Tomato Toy).

SECTION 3: The definitions for this act are as follows: “Zero Point” is a nexus orb composed of pure energy, believed to be the origin of all reality; “Sweating” is a trait describing someone who plays excessively and over-the-top when there is no good or justifiable reason for it; “NPC(s)” are characters in the Fortnite, some controlled by AIs, characters are not playable or characters appear only in the game background and storyline media; “Live Event(s)” are one-off events that occur during gameplay, synchronously across all active servers. SECTION 4: Epic Games, The Seven, The Imagined Order, and the player base of Fortnite shall coordinately oversee the mass-collaboration and execution of restoring and preserving the Zero Point.

SECTION 5. This legislation will take effect at the start of the next season. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

The Four Corners Initiative Act

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Every nation will implement a new curriculum hereby designated as the Four Corners Curriculum, dedicated to teaching the children of all nations a fair and just history of both the interactions between nations and the culture of individual nations.

SECTION 2. A ‘fair and just history’ is defined as an accurate accounting of historical records created by scholars from each nation, and approved by Team Avatar as well as the rulers or heads of each nation (with the de facto head of the Air Nomad nation being Avatar Aang).

SECTION 3. The United Republic Council shall oversee the implementation of this bill to ensure that all nations comply with the guidelines set forth.

The Magical Creatures Protection and Conservation Act

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 2: The purpose of this Act is to: 1.) Preserve magical biodiversity and ecosystems that benefit from magic. 2.) Prevent the harm to any endangered species that possess magic. 3.) Regulate trade of magical creatures and all human-creature interactions. 4.) Promote conservation efforts and education in Magical schools about magical creatures.

SECTION 3: “Magical Creature” is defined as any non-human entity that possesses magical abilities, including but not limited to: beasts, beings, and spirits as classified by the Ministry of Magic. “Endangered Magical Creature” is defined as any species of Magical Creature that is classified as facing extinction by the Department of Magical Control of Creatures.

SECTION 4: “Exploitation of Magical Creatures” is defined as any illicit activity of Magical Creatures, including but not limited to hunting, trade, and capture.

SECTION 5: Habitats of the Unicorn, Merfolk, Dragon, and more will be considered a protected habitat. All hunting, trading, capture, or any other harm to magical creatures is prohibited unless given explicit permission by the Ministry of Magic.

SECTION 6. The Department of Magical Control of Creatures will enforce this act. Licensing for capture, trade, or hunting of Magical Creatures will only be given to acting agizoologists in order for research or protection purposes. Aurors may investigate/take into custody any person involved in the capture, trade, or hunting of any protected Magical Creature. All 11 recognized magical schools will teach a Magical Creature ethics and protection course. The Ministry will provide compensation for any rehabilitation/protection centers for any injured or displaced Magical Creatures. Public awareness campaigns will be encouraged in order to prevent illegal trade and capture of magical creatures.

SECTION 7. Any witch or wizard found in violation of this act will be subjected to: 1.) A fine starting at 5000 galleons, increasing with severity. 2.) Confiscation of illegally pertained creatures or materials. 3.) Temporary or permanent revocation of wands in severe cases. 4.) Possible incarceration in Azkaban for repeated or severe cases.

SECTION 8. If any provision of this act is found to be invalid, all other provisions will remain in force.

SECTION 9. This act will be effective immediately after the passing of it by the WIZEBANDUM.

A Bill to Pass a Mutant Support Act
