

The Climate Change Compromise Act of 2025

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1. **SECTION 1.** The United States shall implement a carbon tax of \$50 per metric ton of
2. carbon emitted by companies.
3. **SECTION 2.** A carbon tax shall be defined as a tax levied on the emission of carbon
4. through the burning of fossil fuels. Companies shall be defined as legal
5. entities that emit greater than 10,000 metric tons of carbon annually.
6. **SECTION 3.** The Department of Energy and the Internal Revenue Service shall be in
7. charge of overseeing and implementing this legislation.
8. **A.** The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) shall collect the tax
9. accordingly and increase the tax by \$10 per metric ton annually
10. for companies who fail to comply.
11. **B.** The tax revenue shall be allocated to the Department of Energy's
12. budget for the research and subsidization of renewable energy
13. sources, as well as the power grid upgrades for the use of
14. renewable energy.
15. **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall be implemented immediately upon passage.
16. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
17. void.
