

A Bill to Provide Natural Disaster Aid to Third-World Countries

BE IT ENACTED BY THIS STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1.     **SECTION I.**         The United States shall provide monetary and catastrophic commodities n
2.                         assistance to third world countries that have experienced an extreme
3.                         natural disaster.
4.     **SECTION II.**       Natural disasters shall be defined as a natural phenomena that
5.                         causes great damage and loss of life, and includes hurricanes,
6.                         earthquakes, volcanic eruptions, and many others. Monetary aid
7.                         shall be defined as providing money based on severity of a natural
8.                         disaster using measures of financial damage. Catastrophic commodities
9.                         aid shall be defined as aid in the form of food, water, resources,
10.                        medication, people, and other resources needed to rebuild. Third world
11.                        countries shall be defined as a country or territory that is poor or
12.                        economically developing.
13.    **SECTION III.**       The United States Federal Emergency Management Agency shall
14.                        work in conjunction with the Department of State to oversee the
15.                        implementation of this legislation.
16.    **SECTION IV.**       This bill shall be implemented immediately upon passage.
17.    **SECTION V.**       All laws in conflict with this legislation shall hereby be declared
18.                        null and void.
