

# **A Bill to Establish Independent Redistricting Commission to Abolish Gerrymandering**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The United States hereby establishes an Independent Redistricting Commission in each of the 50 states to redraw congressional districts every 12 years following the U.S. Census Demographic shift. This Independent Restricting Commission will be created by the state.

**SECTION 2. A.** The Independent Restricting Commission will have its members selected to reflect the state's geographical, racial, gender, and political diversity. The commission will require 8 members, with 2 chosen from the two major political parties respectively, and four independents. Any map will have to pass with eight members in favor of the map to pass.

**B.** Each state will create its own independent redistricting commission. State legislatures shall only reject the district map if they are found to violate the state Constitution or the Constitution of the United States.

**C.** The independent commission will be established every 10 years according to the U.S. Census demographic survey.

**D.** In the case these maps violate the Constitution, redistricting shall be done repeatedly until a map is approved.

**SECTION 3.** The Federal Election Commission will work alongside states to implement this bill. The Federal Election Commission will intervene if it is observed that there exist any discrepancies in any of the terms listed above.

**SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2027. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

**A Bill to Expand Federal Subsidies for Domestic Semiconductor Manufacturing to  
Strengthen Market Independence (Finals)**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The U.S. federal government shall expand subsidies given to domestic semiconductor manufacturers to encourage investments in the USA, and counter China and their stronghold on CHIP manufacturing.

**SECTION 2. A.** Semiconductors shall be defined as a material with electrical conductivity used to control electrical currents in electronic devices such as, but not limited to, phones and laptops.

**B.** Domestic semiconductor manufacturers shall be defined as an entity that designs and assembles semiconductors in the United States.

**C.** Federal subsidies shall be defined as the federal government's financial contribution to support manufacturing, research, and innovation through tax credits, grants, loans, and direct funding.

**SECTION 3.** The Department of Defense and the Department of Commerce shall oversee this legislation and ensure that federal funds are appropriately allocated.

**A.** \$11 billion shall be allocated over the course of five years as competitive grants to ensure domestic competition.

**B.** Tax incentives shall be given proportionally to domestic semiconductor manufacturers investing in research, design, and production based off company size and CHIP investment.

**C.** \$500 million shall be allocated to educational institutions and workforce programs to strengthen talent pipelines.

**SECTION 4.** This bill will take effect on October 1, 2026, at the beginning of Fiscal Year 2027.

**SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# **A Bill to Increase Aid to Haiti**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** \$2 billion will be allocated to Haiti to improve the people's access to necessities and to stabilize the economy.

- A. \$720 million will be allocated to foreign aid through Christian Health Services Corps (CHSC) and the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) to implement the Humanitarian Response Plan for Haiti.
- B. \$1.28 billion will be allocated to foreign direct investment through United States businesses.

**SECTION 2.** Foreign aid shall be defined as money and commodities that the United States provides to other countries. Foreign direct investment shall be defined as investment involving a long-term relationship and reflecting a lasting interest.

**SECTION 3.** The Department of State will oversee the implementation of this legislation.

- A. The Department of State will conduct semiannual investigations to ensure that the funding is properly used and will revoke aid if not properly used.
- B. Funding will be taken from the Department of Defense's discretionary budget.

**SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2027

**SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
