A Bill to Cap Insulin Prices

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** A bill to put a cap on insulin and all insulin products, no matter an
2 individual's insurance coverage, or lack thereof, due to the unnecessary
3 increase of insulin prices. The cap shall make it so no manufacturer or
4 company selling insulin or insulin-related products can sell it for over \$35 a
5 vial or per item.
- 6 **SECTION 2.** A. **Cap:** A set price that companies and manufacturers cannot go over
7 B. **Insulin:** Any and all products that use insulin, including but not limited to
8 insulin pens, insulin pumps, inhaled insulin, and implanted pumps.
- 9 **SECTION 3.** This bill shall be overseen by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and
10 the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) . Any person or
11 company found in violation of this bill shall be fined \$1,000 per offense.
- 12 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect at the beginning of FY 2027.
- 13 **SECTION 5** All laws in conflict with this legislation are *hereby* declared null and void.

A Resolution to Amend the Constitution to Ban Racial Profiling

1 **RESOLVED,** By two-thirds of the Congress here assembled, that the following
2 article is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the
3 United States, which shall be valid to all intents and purposes as
4 part of the Constitution when ratified by the legislatures of three-
5 fourths of the several states within seven years from the date of its
6 submission by the Congress:

ARTICLE--

8
9 **SECTION 1:** No Government authority shall enact any policy,
10 provision, or article that allows the law to be
11 enforced on the basis of race. No official may
12 perform a detainment or search without reasonable
13 suspicion of wrongdoing on behalf of the individual
14 being detained or searched.

SECTION 2: The Congress shall have power to enforce this
article by appropriate legislation.

A Resolution to Encourage Use Of the Gall-Peter's Projection Map to Promote Geographical Accuracy

- 1 **WHEREAS,** The use of the common Mercator projection in schools encourages uneven
2 teaching towards countries near the equator; and
- 3 **WHEREAS,** This affects all students across the country as they view maps and make
4 unfair assumptions between country sizes on the map; and
- 5 **WHEREAS,** Mental maps are formed with Southern and Northern countries being seen
6 as larger and more powerful while equatorial countries are represented as
7 smaller in comparison; and
- 8 **WHEREAS,** The Gall-Peter's Projection Map is an equal-area projection, which means it
9 accurately represents the relative sizes and proportion of landmasses; and
- 10 **WHEREAS,** The use of the Gall-Peter's Projection Map combats Eurocentrism by
11 showing the true size of continents; now, therefore, be it
- 12 **RESOLVED,** That the Congress here assembled should promote the use of the
Gall-Peter's projection map in schools across the country.

A Bill To Implement A 60 day Waiting Period For All Firearm Purchases

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1 **SECTION 1.** Under the passage of this legislation, it will be mandatory to wait for a 60
2 day period to purchase any firearm.

3 **SECTION 2.** The ATF (Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearm and Explosives) will oversee
4 enforcement of this legislation.

5 A. Every violation of this law will result in a \$7,500 dollar fine.

6 B. After 3 violations of this law the violating merchant will be shut down
7 for six weeks in addition to the \$7,500 fine. A fourth violation will
8 result in a permanent shut down in addition to the \$7,500 fine.

9 **SECTION 3.** This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2027.

10 **SECTION 4.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
