

A Bill to Enhance Rare Earth Element Collaboration with Namibia

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** The United States shall provide Namibia with annual economic aid of \$1
2 billion, fostering mutually beneficial partnerships between U.S. companies
3 and local Namibian miners in the rare earth element industry.
- 4 A. This collaboration aligns with the U.S. national security mission to
5 diversify its rare earth elements supply chains and simultaneously
6 contribute to the economic development of Namibia.
- 7 **SECTION 2.** The economic aid shall be utilized to subsidize local Namibian businesses,
8 promoting grassroots economic stabilization initiatives. Additionally, a
9 portion of the aid will be allocated to infrastructure enhancement and the
10 construction of facilities.
- 11 A. In return, U.S. companies shall be granted priority access to partnership
12 opportunities with local miners, ensuring that contracts offered by U.S.
13 companies take precedence over those from other foreign nations.
- 14 B. U.S. companies shall receive full approval from the Namibian
15 government to establish infrastructure for mining and processing
16 facilities on local land.
- 17 **SECTION 3.** The U.S. Department of Defense and the U.S. Agency for International
18 Development will collaborate to implement this legislation.
- 19 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect in FY 2028.
- 20 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

1 **RESOLVED,** That the following article is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution
2 of the United States, which shall be valid to all intents and purposes as part
3 of the Constitution when ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the
4 several states within seven years from the date of its submission by the
5 Congress:

6 **ARTICLE --**

7 **SECTION 1.** In case of the removal of the President from office or their resignation, the
8 highest ranking elected federal officer who is not affiliated with the same
9 political party as that President shall become President. In the case that the
10 outgoing President is not affiliated with a political party, the highest
11 ranking elected federal officer who is affiliated with any party shall become
12 President.

13 **SECTION 2.** If there is no elected federal officer of a different party affiliation anywhere
14 in the Executive or Legislative branch, or in the case of the death of the
15 President, the Vice President shall become President.

16 **SECTION 3.** The remainder of the Presidential Line of Succession as laid out in the 25th
17 Amendment shall be unchanged.

18 **SECTION 4.** The Congress shall have power to enforce this article by appropriate
19 legislation.

A Bill to Make Full-Day Kindergarten Mandatory

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** Each state, territory, and the Federal District must both offer and mandate
2 full-day kindergarten for each student as part of its basic public school
3 education.
- 4 **SECTION 2.** Full-day shall be defined as lasting for an amount of time comparable
5 (within one hour) to that which is expected of students in grades 1-12 in
6 that district.
- 7 **SECTION 3.** Any school district that fails to comply with this legislation shall lose federal
8 education funding until such time as compliance is reached.
- 9 **SECTION 4.** One percent of the Department of Defense budget shall be redirected to
10 the Department of Education to be distributed to states, territories, and
11 the Federal District to ease this transition. School districts which require
12 additional funding to make this transition may apply to their respective
13 education departments for financial support from this fund.
- 14 **SECTION 5.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of Education.
- 15 **SECTION 6.** This legislation shall take effect on July 1, 2027.
- 16 **SECTION 7.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Impose a Temporary Moratorium on New Artificial Intelligence Data Centers

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** A nationwide moratorium shall be placed on the construction of new
2 artificial intelligence (AI) data centers and major expansions of existing AI
3 data centers until Congress enacts comprehensive legislation establishing
4 safety, labor, environmental, and consumer protections for advanced AI
5 systems.
- 6 **SECTION 2.** For the purposes of this legislation:
- 7 A. “Artificial intelligence data center” means a facility primarily dedicated
8 to the training, deployment, or operation of large-scale AI models.
- 9 B. “Major expansion” means any increase in computing capacity of 25% or
10 greater.
- 11 C. “Comprehensive AI safeguards” means federal regulations addressing
12 AI safety standards, workforce impacts, energy consumption,
13 environmental impacts, and transparency requirements.
- 14 **SECTION 3.** The Department of Commerce shall oversee enforcement of this
15 moratorium.
- 16 A. Existing data centers may continue operation and perform routine
17 maintenance.
- 18 B. The Department of Commerce shall submit annual reports to Congress
19 evaluating AI’s effects on employment, infrastructure, energy
20 consumption, and public safety.
- 21 **SECTION 4.** The United States shall restrict exports of advanced AI computing
22 infrastructure to nations lacking comparable AI safety regulations, as
23 determined by the Department of Commerce.
- 24 **SECTION 5.** This legislation will take effect within 90 days after passage.
- 25 **SECTION 6.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
