


Non-DPS Employees DPSGuest Wireless Network

This guide is for individuals who **do not** have a DPS employee account, such as vendors, parents, and other non-DPS employees.



On a PC:

1. Access the list of available wireless connections.
2. Select the **dpsguest** network.
3. Click on **Connect**.

On a Mac:




1. Click on the wireless icon on the toolbar.

Launch any web browser –

4. Click **Register**.
